Every two years, The OR Society awards the Cook Medal for the best paper appearing in the *Knowledge Management Research & Practice Journal*. We're seeking a volunteer to join the judging panel for this award.

Applications must be in by midday on Friday 12 December.

All papers published in the qualifying period are assessed and a shortlist of potential winners is produced. This shortlist is combined with the editors' recommendations for final assessment to select a winning paper using the following criteria:

- impact on the real world, including OR/IS community (actual impact)
- relevance to the real world (potential impact)
- degree of innovation
- quality of technical content
- quality of writing
